Rule Name : Hazardous Surcharge

Effective Date : June 18, 2007

Summary as follows:

The following hazardous cargo surcharge is applicable for ALL HAZARDOUS CARGO MOVING UNDER SERVICE CONTRACT OR TARIFF:

IN the absence of specific provision of this tariff, all commodities designated, either specifically by name or qualified reason of characteristics or properties as

Hazardous Materials/Dangerous Goods, as prescribed in the United States Code

of Federal Regulations, ie. CFR Titles 46 and 49 as revised and/or the International

Maritime Dangerous Goods Code (IMDG) as implemented shall be considered as Hazardous Materials/Dangerous Goods and rated accordingly.

Hazardous cargo will be assessed an additional \$100 per container based on direct call

service and \$200 per container based on non-direct call service (unless otherwise noted).

**Note: Direct call service is based on Direct Call at Origin and at Destination.**

**Non-Direct service is valid for cargo requiring transshipment at Destination, but is**

**still based on direct call at origin.**
