Pakistan - Strike

Dear Valued Customer,

Maersk Line would like to advise that due to current political unrest in Pakistan, a "general strike" is planned from May 25th to May 27th. Should the strike occur, the result could slow down the movement of containers from manufacturing facilities to the Port of Qasim.

The next direct Maersk Line departure from Pakistan to the United States is the "Grasmere Maersk" voyage #0710 on our MECL1 service, departing Port Qasim May 29th, 2007, and arriving at the below United States East Coast ports:

- Newark – June 18th
- Norfolk – June 20th
- Charleston – June 22nd

Should your cargo not make it to Port Qasim in time for the "Grasmere Maersk" departure, bookings should be moved to the following week's vessel, the "Maersk Georgia" voyage #0710, departing Port Qasim on June 5th, 2007 and arriving at the below United States East Coast ports:

- Newark – June 25th
- Norfolk – June 27th
- Charleston – June 29th
